



Cush4Christ Prayer Points – February 2012

“...the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp and golden bowls of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.” Rev. 5:8

Some suggestions for use of this prayer guide:

- Individually (daily, weekly, or monthly)
- As a family (for worship daily, weekly, or monthly)
- In a group: call people in your area to meet together monthly to pray

C4C TEAM

1. Pray Eph. 1:17-19 for the team (Vince & Julie Ward, Daniel & Natalie Faris, Scott Brinkerhoff, Jan Buchanan, James Brinkerhoff, Zach Smith).
2. Scott's travels and return to the field: he will be leaving the States mid-February, visiting his missionary sister and her church in Japan, spending some days doing errands in Nairobi, then arriving back on the field on February 24.
3. Praise God for short-termers! Zach Smith, who arrived Jan. 20, has been adapting well and is a blessing to the team with his servant heart and cheerful disposition. Aaron Dinkledine, from Indiana, will be coming in with Scott to join our team until mid-July. He will be helping with the construction project.
4. Wisdom, grace and stamina for James as he oversees the work at Weer Bei radio and takes care of the radio compound until Scott returns.
5. Stamina for the team for the very hot weather of February and March.
6. Wisdom for Vince as he leads the team, and good communication among team members.

CHURCH PLANTING MINISTRY

7. Praise God for the excellent Aweil Community Church (ACC) pastors' retreat that took place at the end of December. The men spent much time in prayer, discussed the church evaluations done in November, received teaching on spiritual warfare and had good fellowship together. Pray for continued unity, spiritual growth and wisdom for the six pastors: Karlo, Kerubino, Thomas, Peter, Emmanuel and John.
8. Training that will be taking place in February: start-up of the advanced pastoral/theological training program for the pastors; workshops on evangelism; training of deacons.
9. Ongoing training of the third generation of church planters/future pastors: Dammasio, John and Archangelo.
10. The first marriage workshop for ACC church leaders was held in January and it was an enriching time of teaching, discussion and prayer. Pray that the seven couples who attended would continue to grow in their understanding and practice of biblical marriage, that their marriages would be strengthened, that they would influence others in their churches, and that other marriage workshops would take place in local churches.
11. In January half of the 7000 bricks required for the new Crossroads Training Centre building were made and the foundation dug. Continue to pray for wisdom for Daniel and James as they oversee the local workers and all the other aspects of the construction project.
12. The church in Loul Kou is about to plant a daughter church: ten members of the church who live in a village called Karic want to start a church there.

RADIO MINISTRY

13. That the new radio equipment would work well.
14. Praise God that 5,300 new radios have been distributed. Pray for God's direction in the distribution of the 1700 remaining radios, and that those who receive them would become faithful listeners of Weer Bei FM.
15. Radio plans/challenges for 2012: add live broadcasting, a children's program and a program providing instruction in sound doctrine.
16. Radio listeners: conversions; spiritual growth; churches planted among them.
17. Radio staff: continued spiritual growth and growth in professional skills and responsibility.
18. God's provision for the ongoing operational costs of the radio ministry.

STUDENT MINISTRY

19. God's provision of the curriculum to be used at the new Parot Community Church school.
20. Training this month of the three Parot school teachers (Dammasio, John Alou and Mayar) in how to teach children to read using Dinka literacy materials.
21. Good leadership and spiritual growth of the BLYCSA (Better Living for Young Christians Secondary School Association) groups starting up again this month in Aweil and Mayar Bai, particularly for the students who are in their last year of secondary school.
22. That the BLYCSA students who have graduated would persevere and grow in their faith and be faithful members of a local church.
23. Wisdom for Parot CC School director Dammasio and the teachers as they conduct interviews with parents who wish to enroll their children in the school.
24. Expansion of the BLYCSA groups to new schools: that God would raise up leaders for the groups; wisdom for Dammasio as he oversees the groups and encourages the leaders.

MERCY MINISTRY

25. Praise God for the many answered prayers for the dental training provided by Dr. Jim Albee to pastors Thomas and Kerubino. It was excellent. Pray for Thomas and Kerubino as they start up their dental work: for growth in skill; wisdom as they set prices and choose locations; and opportunities to share the gospel.
26. We need to find reliable, accessible, reasonably-priced sources of consumable supplies needed for the dental ministry.
27. For local farmers: good preparation of land and building fences for the next season of cultivation, which will begin, Lord willing, with the rains in April.
28. Good rains for this next growing season.
29. Wisdom for deacons in the churches as they minister to their churches and communities through various kinds of practical help and prayer.
30. God's guidance and wisdom in the preparatory field research and the development of health education teaching.
