



Cush4Christ Prayer Update – November 2011

“...in everything, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.” Phil. 4:6

Some suggestions for use of this update:

- Individually (daily, weekly, or monthly)
- As a family (for worship daily, weekly, or monthly)
- In a group: call people in your area to meet together monthly to pray (maybe some refreshments will attract even more people!)

C4C TEAM

1. Pray Ephesians 3:16-19 for the team (Vince & Julie Ward, Daniel & Natalie Faris, Scott Brinkerhoff, Jan Buchanan, James Brinkerhoff).
2. Good relationships with neighbors and wisdom to know how to respond to their requests for help of various kinds.
3. Physical health; safety from injury and from harmful creatures like snakes.
4. Wisdom for Julie and Natalie as they teach their children.
5. The Ward family and Jan will be away from the field on R&R from early November until mid-December. Pray for refreshment and for safety as they travel.
6. Stamina, wisdom and encouragement for the Farises, Scott and James as they remain on the field with more responsibilities in the absence of the other members of the team.

CHURCH PLANTING MINISTRY

7. Presbytery visits: the six teaching elders (pastors) of our partner denomination (Aweil Community Church) will be going in pairs to visit the ten churches in the presbytery and evaluate them in several areas. Pray for discernment for the elders and that they would give good counsel to the churches.
8. Faithful tithing of church members' harvests by mid-November.
9. The local churches are launching small groups that will meet weekly from Nov.-March to go through discipleship lessons. Pray that all the adults and youth in each church will be part of a group and that people will attend faithfully.
10. Madhol and Aweil town, two places where there is currently a Bible study and we want to see a fellowship group established within the next two months. Pray for God's choice of men to lead these future new churches.
11. Wisdom for the pastors to know which new communities to target next for church planting.
12. Spiritual and overall maturity for the young men in generations 4 and 5 of the church planter training program as they progress through the training (most are in their early 20s).

RADIO MINISTRY

13. Praise God for the extension of the height of the radio tower done at the end of October; now tens of thousands more people will be able to hear the Weer Bei FM broadcasts.
14. Wisdom in planning for the distribution of more than 4000 solar-powered radios received from Aid Sudan.
15. Spiritual and physical health of the Weer Bei FM staff, who prepare the daily programs and present them: Karlo, Luka, Immanuel and Peter.
16. Wisdom in crafting a children's program.

17. Wisdom in the planning for a new program providing teaching in theology.
18. Weer Bei FM listeners: that Christians would be strengthened in their faith and non-Christians convicted of sin and drawn to the Savior.

STUDENT MINISTRY

19. Two secondary school students, Wol in Aweil town and Bol in Marial Bai, who are leading fruitful discipleship groups in their schools.
20. The secondary school Bible fellowship groups in Yargot and Majok Kar have not been strong this year; pray that they would finish the year well (the school year ends this month) and be stronger next year (schools start up again in April).
21. Graduation ceremonies will be held at the end of this month for faithful student fellowship members, who will receive a certificate and a Bible; pray that the students will be encouraged by this and will continue to grow in their faith.
22. Thank God for Damasio, the coordinator of the student fellowship groups, who has done a wonderful job overseeing the groups this school year.
23. Pray for Damasio as he is trained by Scott in the philosophy of Christian education and then communicates this knowledge to the other two men who will join him as teachers at the new Parot Community Church School that we hope to start in April.
24. That the Parot church members would commit to joyfully and generously give to support the new school.

MERCY MINISTRY

25. Daniel and James are making visits to five key people to help them begin preparing their land for the next growing season; these five will grow demonstration gardens to show the value of new agricultural techniques that should give greater yields.
26. Wisdom in knowing how to help a local woman named Adut who has chronic asthma; pray also for her healing and salvation.
27. Preparations for health teaching based on a biblical world view (Creation, Fall, Redemption) that will start early next year.
28. That the church deacons and church members would be ministering informally to the orphans and widows in their communities.
29. That the hungry and sick would receive help from the local churches.
30. Wisdom for the team and local partners in the use of medicinal plants and teaching about them.
